## 10. REQUEST PROCESS

- 10.1. An individual who wishes to place a request must comply with all the procedures laid down in PAIA. The requester must complete the prescribed form, which is attached hereto as annexure "A". The prescribed form must be submitted as well as payment of a request fee and a deposit, if applicable to the information officer at the postal or physical address, fax number or electronic mail as is stated herein.
- 10.2. The prescribed form must be completed with enough particularity to enable the information officer to determine:
  - 10.2.1. The record(s) requested;
  - 10.2.2. The identity of the requestor;
  - 10.2.3. What form of access is required; and
  - 10.2.4. The Postal address or fax number of the requestor.
- 10.3. The requestor must state that the records are required for the requestor to exercise or protect a right, and clearly state what the nature of the right is so to be exercised or protected. An explanation of why the records requested is required to exercise or protect the right.
- 10.4. The request for access will be dealt with within 30 days from date of receipt, unless the requestor has set out special grounds that satisfy the information officer that the request be dealt with sooner.
- 10.5. The period of 30 days may be extended by not more than 30 additional days, if the request is for a large quantity of information, or the request requires a search for information held at another office of the Company and the information cannot be reasonably obtained within 30 days. The information officer will notify the requestor in writing should an extension be necessary.
- 10.6. The requestor will be informed in writing whether access to the records have been granted or denied. If the requestor requires a reason for the decision the request must be expressed in the prescribed form, the requestor must be further stated what particulars of the reasoning the requestor requires.
- 10.7. If a requestor has requested the records on another individual's behalf, the requestor must submit proof of the capacity the requestor submits the request in, to the satisfaction of the information officer.





10.8. If the requestor is unable to complete the prescribed form due to illiteracy or disability, the requestor may request it orally from the information officer.

## 11. GROUNDS FOR REFUSAL

- 11.1. The following are grounds upon which the Company may, subject to the exceptions in Chapter 4 of PAIA, refuse a request for access in accordance with Chapter 4 of PAIA:
- 11.1.1. Mandatory protection of the privacy of a third party who is a natural person, including a deceased person, where such disclosure of Personal Information would be unreasonable
  - 11.1.2. Mandatory protection of the commercial information of a third party, if the Records contain:
    - 11.1.3. Trade secrets of that third party;
    - 11.1.4. Financial, commercial, scientific or technical information of the third party, the disclosure of which could likely cause harm to the financial or commercial interests of that third party; and/or
    - 11.1.5. Information disclosed in confidence by a third party to the Company, the disclosure of which could put that third party at a disadvantage in contractual or other negotiations or prejudice the third party in commercial competition;
    - 11.1.6. Mandatory protection of confidential information of third parties if it is protected in terms of any agreement;
    - 11.1.7. Mandatory protection of the safety of individuals and the protection of property;
    - 11.1.8. Mandatory protection of Records that would be regarded as privileged in legal proceedings;
    - 11.1.9. Protection of the commercial information of the Company, which may include:
      - 11.1.10. Trade secrets;
      - 11.1.11. Financial/commercial, scientific or technical information, the disclosure of which could likely cause harm to the financial or commercial interests of the Company;
      - 11.1.12. Information which, if disclosed, could put the Company at a disadvantage in contractual or other negotiations or prejudice the Company in commercial competition; and/or
      - 11.1.13. Computer programs which are owned by the Company, and which are protected by copyright and intellectual property laws;
      - 11.1.14. Research information of the Company or a third party, if such disclosure would place the research or the researcher at a serious disadvantage; and
      - 11.1.15. Requests for Records that are clearly frivolous or vexatious, or which involve an unreasonable diversion of resources.

## 12. REMEDIES SHOULD A REQUEST BE REFUSED

- 12.1. The fee for a copy of the manual as contemplated in regulation 9(2)(c) is R1,10 for every photocopy of an A4-size page or part thereof.
- 12.2. The fees for reproduction referred to in regulation 11(1) are as follows:

  - 12.5.13. Six hours as the hours to be exceeded before a deposit is payable; and
  - 12.5.14. one third of the access fee is payable as a deposit by the requester.
  - 12.5.15. The actual postage is payable when a copy of a record must be posted to a requester.

    - 13.3.14. The Company, the Company's affiliates, their respective representatives
    - 13.3.15. When making authorised disclosures or transfers of personal information in terms of Section 72 of POPI, personal information may be disclosed to recipients in countries that do not have the same level of protection for personal information as South Africa does.
  - 13.3.16. The Company implements numerous Security measures to protect personal information that is stored electronically and physically.
  - 13.3.17. The Company ensures that appropriate security measures are taken and updates these measures on a regular basis.
  - 13.3.18. The Company have also implemented various policies to additional security such as the confidentiality policy, Information Security Breach Policy, Minimum Access Policy, Password Construction Policy, Password Protection Policy, Server Security Policy and data protection.
  - 13.3.19. The personal information that is stored physically is protected as follows:
    - 13.3.20. Where physical records of the data exist, such records will be stored in a secure area that can be 'locked-away' as to avoid a breach of the personal information.
    - 13.3.21. Such physical data records will be 'locked-away' and secured when not in use.
  - 13.3.22. The Company have also implemented various policies to additional security such as the confidentiality policy, data protection policy and a clean desk policy.
  - 13.3.23. The Company may share personal information with third parties and in certain instances this may result in cross border flow of the personal information. The personal information will always be subject to protection, not less than the protection it is afforded under the Protection of Personal Information Act No.4 of 2013.
- 13.4. Objection to the processing of personal information by a data subject:
  - 13.4.1. Section 11(3) of POPI and regulation 2 of the POPI regulations provides that a data subject may, at any time object to the processing of their personal information in the prescribed form attached to this manual as annexure "B".
- 13.5. Request for correction or deletion of personal information:
